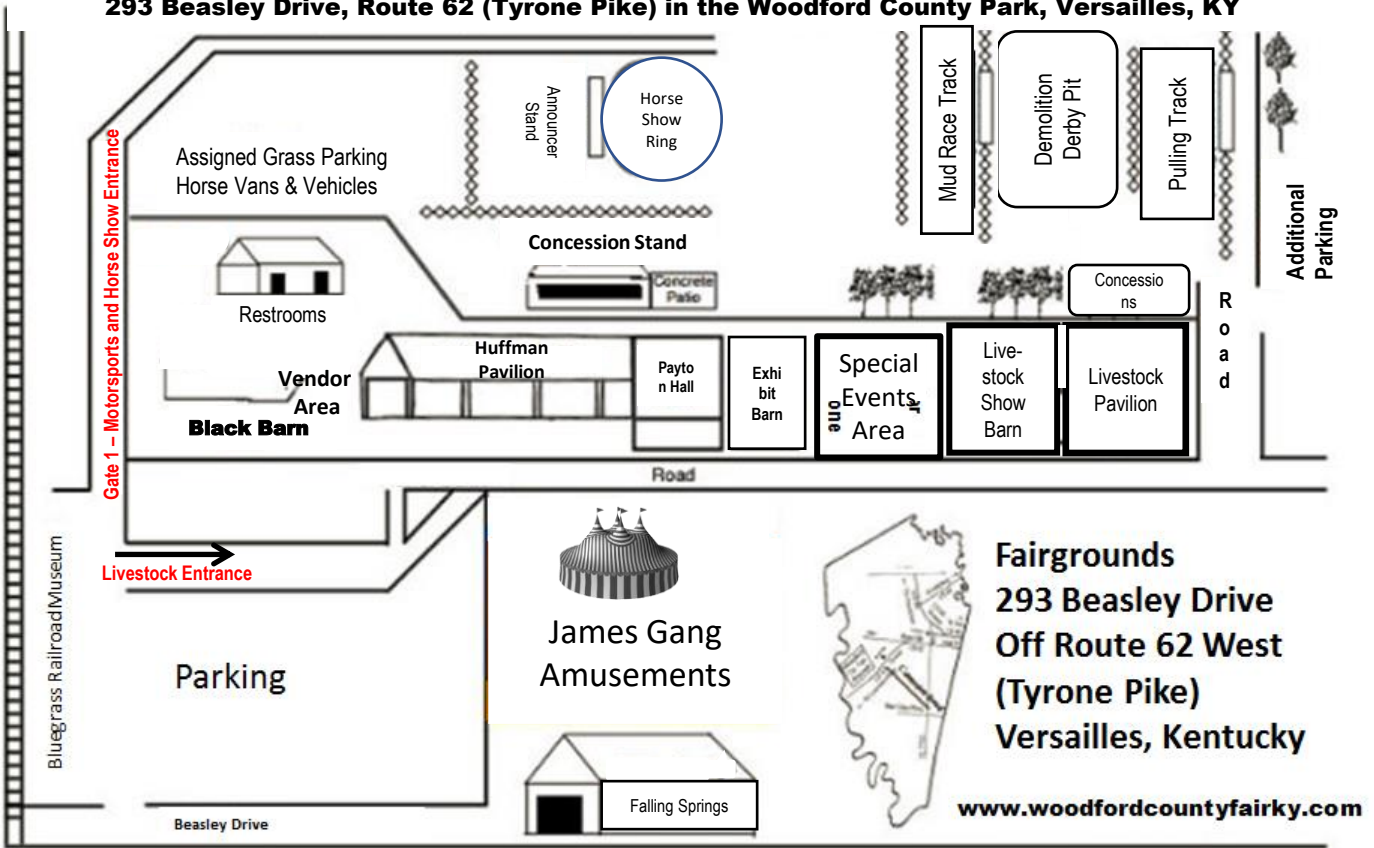

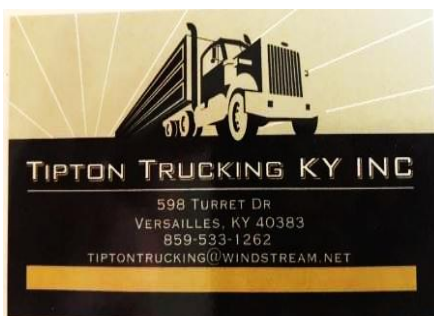

This event will be a one round, scheduled flex-start with tee times. Participants must select an available tee time during online registration. Divisions may be mixed.

Division Tees: Open, MA1 and MA40 Divisions will play from the long tees. All other divisions will throw from the short tees. If your card has mixed divisions that are playing both long and short tees, please allow players from the long tees to progress past the short tees before advancing.

Tee Times: Tee times must be strictly adhered to. Groups of 3 to 4 will tee off every 10 minutes. Tee times will be finalized on **Friday May 31st at 8pm.**

1. Entry form must be completely filled out with breed name, variety (if applicable), sex and class.
2. The filling of an entry form indicates acceptance of rules and regulations. ARBA rules apply.
3. No does and litters accepted.
4. Rabbit must be in a carrier or cage with a bottom. No boxes allowed. The exhibitor must furnish.
5. All rabbits MUST be permanently and legibly earmarked in the animals' left ear. Does not apply to mixed breed.
6. Any rabbit showing symptoms of disease will not be allowed to compete.
7. All rabbits that are overweight or under-weight will be eliminated.
8. Youth classes for those age 18 and under. Open classes are open to everyone.

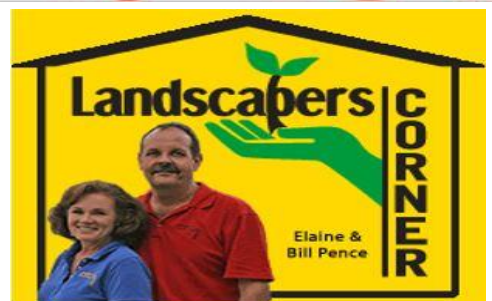

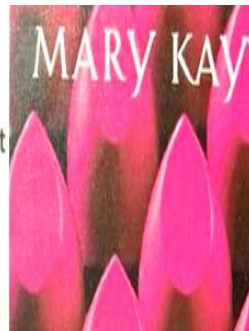

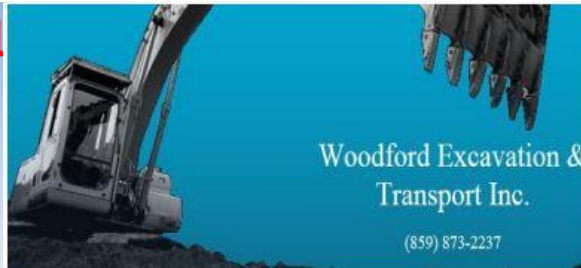
