- A. Every entry must be labeled with the name of the item being entered, name, address, and phone number of the exhibitor. Exhibits must be entered with the superintendent in charge.
- B. Categories are open to any person 18 years of age or older.
- C. One entry per person per class. Item(s) must be entered under the name of the person who made it and completed within the past 2 years. Any item having won a blue ribbon in the last 2 years will NOT be eligible.
- D. Paper plates are to be used for food items. WCFA is not responsible for dinnerware if used. Clear plastic bags are recommended.
- E. Judges will determine ribbon placement. Items are judged on quality; therefore, ribbons may not be awarded in every category, or a blue ribbon may not always be given. Decisions made by judges are final.
- F. No one is allowed in the exhibit hall during judging except judges, extension agents, and committee members.
- G. To pick up entries, exhibitors must show entry ticket stub to the superintendent(s) in charge. Items removed before the pickup date will forfeit ribbon winnings. WCFA is not responsible for items not picked up by June 9.

CANNING & FOOD PRESERVATION

Use standard canning jars that are manufactured for preparing home canned food. All jars are to be processed and sealed, with 2 piece lids applied (flat lid plus ring). Jars will not be opened.
